Subject: Camp 4 FTT Discussions

Dear Supervisors Farr and Adams:

I have been following the County/Chumash discussions which have resulted in a proposed "Term Sheet". The "Introduction" suggests the County would support Camp 4 Fee-To-Trust if an agreement is forthcoming from these discussions. This sets a dangerous precedent for more and more annexations by the Chumash. This proposal in the "Introduction" should be eliminated.

I am writing to register my strong opinion that the Ad Hoc Subcommittee and the County should not in any way condone or offer Fee to Trust (FTT) nor violate the Williamson Act on any property owned by the Band. This is the stated position of the Board of Supervisors as established by Board action on a 4:1 vote on October 15, 2013. The Board did not extend authority to the Ad Hoc Committee to negotiate Fee to Trust. The current FTT discussions are completely inappropriate without a return to the Board to reconsider their October 15, 2013 position in a full public hearing.

The current offer in the Term Sheet of FTT and zoning changes must be abandoned immediately, and full public participation allowed before previous public votes and Community Planning are unilaterally upended without the proper authority.
