As a Santa Barbara County citizen, taxpayer and voter, I support full public participation before previous public votes and Community Planning are unilaterally upended without proper authority, as it is my understanding that the Board of Supervisors did not extend authority to the Ad Hoc Subcommittee to negotiate Fee to Trust.
