The County Board of Supervisors will consider ordinance and policy amendments concerning the land use activities associated with Cannabis, including:

1. Case No. 17ORD-00000-00004. Amend the Santa Barbara County Land Use and Development Code, Section 35-1 of Chapter 35, Zoning, of the County Code.
2. Case No. 17ORD-00000-00010. Amend the Coastal Zoning Ordinance, of Chapter 35, Zoning, of the County Code.
3. Case No. 17ORD-00000-00009. Amend the Montecito Land Use Development Code, Section 35-2 of Chapter 35, Zoning, of the County Code.
4. Case No. 17ORD-00000-00019. Amend the Santa Barbara County Uniform Rules for Agricultural Preserves and Farmland Security Zones.
5. Case No. 18ORD-00000-00001. Amend and partially rescind Article X, Medical Marijuana Regulations, of Chapter 35, Zoning, of the County Code.
6. Case No. 17EIR-00000-00003. Certify the Cannabis Land Use Ordinance and Licensing Program Final Programmatic Environmental Impact Report (State Clearinghouse No. 2017071016) pursuant to the State Guidelines for Implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act.
7. Adopt a resolution transmitting Case No. 17ORD-00000-00010 (CZO) to the Coastal Commission for certification by the California Coastal Commission as an amendment to Santa Barbara County's certified Local Coastal Program .
