BACK UP POLL WORKERS NEEDED FOR THE NOVEMBER 6, 2018 GENERAL ELECTION *Training Classes Being Held Saturday, Nov. 3*

(SANTA BARBARA, Calif.) – The Santa Barbara County Registrar of Voters office is looking for volunteers who are able to attend a Pollworker Training class on Saturday, November 3 in north and south county:

Polling Place Coordinator/Traffic Clerks: 9 to 11 a.m.

Inspector/Clerks: 1 to 4:30 p.m.

Pollworker Training Classes are being held at:

SBC Employees University at 267 Camino Del Remedio, Santa Barbara

Santa Barbara County (BOS room) at 511 E. Lakeside Parkway, Santa Maria

Back-Up pollworkers must be available to serve as poll workers for the November 6, 2018 if called upon to fill a last minute cancellation.

Back-Up Poll workers who are called to fill in for a pollworker at a polling place receive a stipend of \$180 to \$240. Each polling place has one or more Precinct Boards comprised of one inspector and two to four clerks. Each polling place has a coordinator and if needed, a traffic clerk. To be a poll worker, you must meet the following criteria:

- Be a registered voter in the State of California or lawfully admitted for permanent residence in the United States, as specified, and who is otherwise eligible to register to vote, except for his or her lack of United States citizenship.
- Be able to follow written and verbal instruction.
- Be available to serve Election Day (November 6) from approximately 6 a.m. to 9 p.m. or until all of the closing procedures have been completed.
- Must be available to attend a mandatory training class.
