How Years of Service are calculated for Service Pins

Your start date is the first date of employment as a civil service employee. Each year the count ends at the end of the calendar year -- 12/31. If you have five, ten, fifteen, twenty, twenty-five or thirty years on 12/31, then they you will receive your service pin at the next All-Staff Gathering.

If you move from one Santa Barbara County department to another, the clock never stops. If you move out-of-county and return to work for Santa Barbara County, the clock restarts when then you return. All unpaid leave will stop the clock, and it will start again upon the new start date. The clock does not stop during medical leave.
