Provide an update to the maintenance funding numbers.

Following is a report of major maintenance funding sources, including General Fund and special revenue funds, for the Public Works, General Services, and Community Services Departments, for the FY 2016-17 adopted, FY 2017-18 adopted, and FY 2018-19 recommended budgets.

Ongoing General Fund committed to maintenance has grown from \$4.8 million in FY 2016-17 to \$5.6 million in FY 2017-18 and a recommended \$6.7 million in FY 2018-19. Major special revenue sources have provided increasing funding for roads maintenance, including \$15.1 million in FY 2016-17, \$18.4 million in FY 2017-18, and \$22.1 million recommended in FY 2018-19. The largest driver of this increase for roads is SB 1, which provided new revenue of \$2.8 million in FY 2017-18 and an expected \$6.4 million in FY 2018-19.
