RE: People v David Guillod: Santa Barbara County Superior Court Case Number 20CR80026

Joyce E. Dudley announced today that the Santa Barbara County District Attorney's Office has filed a felony complaint charging David Guillod with the following:

As to the alleged sexual assault upon Jane Doe 1, on or about December 14, 2014, in the County of Santa Barbara, the defendant is charged with, Count 1: Kidnap for Rape, in violation of P.C. §209(b)(1); Count 2: Rape of a Person Prevented from Resisting Due to an Intoxicating, Anesthetic or Controlled Substance, in violation of P.C. § 261(a)(3); and Count 3: Rape of Unconscious Person, in violation of P.C. § 261(a)(4)(C).

As to the alleged sexual assault upon Jane Doe 2, on or about May 21, 2012, in the County of Los Angeles, the defendant is charged with, Count 4: Sexual Penetration of an Intoxicated Person By A Foreign Object, in violation of P.C. § 289(e); Count 5: Sexual Penetration of an Unconscious Person by a Foreign Object in violation of P.C. § 289(d); Count 6: Oral Copulation with a Person Prevented From Resisting due to an Intoxicating, Anesthetic or Controlled Substance, in violation of P.C. § 288a(i); and in Count 7: Oral Copulation with an Unconscious Person, in violation of P.C. § 288a(f).

As to the alleged sexual assault upon Jane Doe 3, on or between January 30, 2015 and January 31, 2015, in the County of Los Angeles the defendant is charged with, Count 8: Rape of a Person Prevented from Resisting Due to an Intoxicating, Anesthetic or Controlled Substance, in violation of P.C. § 261(a)(3); and Count 9: Rape of Unconscious Person, in violation of P.C. § 261(a)(4)(C).

As to the alleged sexual assault upon Jane Doe 4, on or between January 30, 2015 and January 31, 2015, in the County of Los Angeles the defendant is charged with, Count 10: Rape of a Person Prevented from Resisting Due to an Intoxicating, Anesthetic or Controlled Substance, in violation of P.C. § 261(a)(3); and Count 11: Rape of Unconscious Person, in violation of P.C. § 261(a)(4)(C).

Charges were filed after extensive investigations were conducted by the Santa Barbara County Sheriff's Department and the Los Angeles Police Department, while working in conjunction with the District Attorneys of Santa Barbara County and Los Angeles County. After reviewing all the evidence, the Santa Barbara County District Attorney requested jurisdiction from the District Attorney of Los Angeles to prosecute Counts 4-11 in Santa Barbara.

The defendant is currently in custody at the Santa Barbara County Jail, with bail set at 3 million dollars. The court has ordered that GPS be a term and condition of his bail, and has ordered that the defendant have no contact with the victims. His arraignment date is yet to be determined. If convicted as charged, the defendant faces a potential sentence of 21 years to life in prison.
