**FELONY COMPLAINT**

**AB109 INELIGIBLE**

The undersigned is informed and believes that:

**COUNT 1**

On or about January 7, 2021, in the County of Santa Barbara, the crime of MURDER, in violation of **PENAL CODE SECTION 187(a)**, a Felony, was committed by BRYAN MUNOZ and JOHN DOE, who did unlawfully, and with malice aforethought murder ENZO MARINO RASTELLI, a human being.

It is further alleged that the above offense is a serious felony within the meaning of **Penal Code Section 1192.7(c)(1)**.

It is further alleged that the above offense is a violent felony within the meaning of **Penal Code Section 667.5(c)(1)**.

**SPECIAL ALLEGATION – STREET TERRORISM**

It is further alleged pursuant to **Penal Code Section 186.22(b) (1) (C)** that the above offense was committed by BRYAN MUNOZ for the benefit of or at the direction of or in association with a criminal street gang, to wit: WESTSIDE (SANTA BARBARA) with the specific intent to promote, or further, or assist in criminal conduct by gang members.

"NOTICE: The above offense is a violent felony within the meaning of **Penal Code Section 667.5(C)(7)(8)(12)** and a serious felony within the meaning of Penal Code section **1192.7(c) (28)**."

**SPEC ALLEG-PERSONAL AND INTENTIONAL DISCHARGE OF A FIREARM, GBI**

It is further alleged as to the defendant(s), BRYAN MUNOZ, in the commission of the foregoing offenses, a principal personally and intentionally discharged a firearm, to wit: a 9 mm handgun, and proximately caused death to a person other than the accomplice, to wit: ENZO MARINO RASTELLI, within the meaning of §12022.53 (d) & (e) of the Penal Code.

**SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCE  
MULTIPLE MURDER**

It is further alleged that the offense(s) charged in count(s) 1 and 2 are a special circumstance indicating a multiple murder that is within the meaning of **PENAL CODE SECTION 190.2(a)(3)**.

**SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCE  
MURDER COMMITTED FOR  
CRIMINAL STREET GANG PURPOSES**

It is further alleged, pursuant to **PENAL CODE SECTION 190.2(a)(22)**, that the defendant BRYAN MUNOZ intentionally killed ENZO MARINO RASTELLI, while the defendant was an active participant in WESTSIDE (SANTA BARBARA), a criminal street gang, and that the murder was carried out to further the activities of the criminal street gang.

**COUNT 2**

On or about January 7, 2021, in the County of Santa Barbara, the crime of MURDER, in violation of **PENAL CODE SECTION 187(a)**, a Felony, was committed by BRYAN MUNOZ and JOHN DOE, who did unlawfully, and with malice aforethought murder JASPER PIETER VANDERMEULEN, a human being.

It is further alleged that the above offense is a serious felony within the meaning of **Penal Code Section 1192.7(c)(1)**.

It is further alleged that the above offense is a violent felony within the meaning of **Penal Code Section 667.5(c)(1)**.

**SPECIAL ALLEGATION – STREET TERRORISM**

It is further alleged pursuant to **Penal Code Section 186.22(b) (1) (C)** that the above offense was committed by BRYAN MUNOZ for the benefit of or at the direction of or in association with a criminal street gang, to wit: WESTSIDE (SANTA BARBARA) with the specific intent to promote, or further, or assist in criminal conduct by gang members.

"NOTICE: The above offense is a violent felony within the meaning of **Penal Code Section 667.5(C)(7)(8)(12)** and a serious felony within the meaning of Penal Code section **1192.7(c) (28)**."

**SPEC ALLEG-PERSONAL AND INTENTIONAL DISCHARGE OF A FIREARM, GBI**

It is further alleged as to the defendant(s), BRYAN MUNOZ, in the commission of the foregoing offenses, a principal personally and intentionally discharged a firearm, to wit: a 9 mm handgun, and proximately caused death to a person other than the accomplice, to wit: JASPER PIETER VANDERMEULEN, within the meaning of **§12022.53 (d) & (e)** of the Penal Code.

**SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCE  
MULTIPLE MURDER**

It is further alleged that the offense(s) charged in count(s) 1 and 2 are a special circumstance indicating a multiple murder that is within the meaning of **PENAL CODE SECTION 190.2(a)(3)**.

**SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCE  
MURDER COMMITTED FOR  
CRIMINAL STREET GANG PURPOSES**

It is further alleged, pursuant to **PENAL CODE SECTION 190.2(a)(22)**, that the defendant BRYAN MUNOZ intentionally killed JASPER PIETER VANDERMEULEN, while the defendant was an active participant in WESTSIDE (SANTA BARBARA), a criminal street gang, and that the murder was carried out to further the activities of the criminal street gang.

**COUNT 3**

On or about January 7, 2021, in the County of Santa Barbara, the crime of **CONSPIRACY TO COMMIT A CRIME**, in violation of **PENAL CODE SECTION 182(a)(1)**, a Felony, was committed by BRYAN MUNOZ and JOSHUA ISAAC VEGA and JOHN DOE, who did unlawfully conspire together and with another person and persons whose identity is unknown to commit the crime of **ROBBERY**, in violation of Section 211, of the Penal Code, a Felony and that pursuant to and for the purpose of carrying out the objects and purposes of the aforesaid conspiracy, the said defendant(s) committed the following overt act and acts at and in the County of SANTA BARBARA:

**OVERT ACTS:**

1. On 1/5/21 in the County of Santa Barbara defendant Bryan Munoz received a message from victim Jasper van der Meulen stating that the price for half pound of marijuana is 1K.
2. On 1/6/21 in the County of Santa Barbara defendant Bryan Munoz messaged back victim Jasper van der Meulen stating that "my bro and I want to go half on the HP would you be able to deliver today"?
3. On 1/7/21 defendant Bryan Munoz and victim Van der Meulen agreed to meet in the County of Santa Barbara and exchange a HP of marijuana for 1K;
4. On 1/7/21 in the County of Santa Barbara defendant Bryan Munoz and John Doe. secured fake currency from defendant Joshua Isaac Vega and discussed robbing victims Jasper Van der Meulen and Enzo Rastelli of their marijuana;
5. On 1/7/21 in the County of Santa Barbara defendant Munoz and John Doe secure a 9 mm handgun to rob victims Jasper Van der Meulen and Enzo Rastelli;
6. On 1/7/21 in the County of Santa Barbara defendants Bryan Munoz and John Doe met victims Enzo Rastelli and Jasper Van der Meulen to commit robbery;
7. On 1/7/21 during the course of the robbery victims Jasper van der Meulen Van and Enzo Rastelli were unlawfully shot and unlawfully killed with a 9 mm handgun.

**SPECIAL ALLEGATION – STREET TERRORISM**

It is further alleged pursuant to **Penal Code Section 186.22(b) (1) (C)** that the above offense was committed by BRYAN MUNOZ for the benefit of or at the direction of or in association with a criminal street gang, to wit: WESTSIDE (SANTA BARBARA) with the specific intent to promote, or further, or assist in criminal conduct by gang members.

"NOTICE: The above offense is a violent felony within the meaning of **Penal Code Section 667.5(C)(7)(8)(12)** and a serious felony within the meaning of Penal Code section **1192.7(c) (28)**."

**SPEC ALLEG-PERSONAL AND INTENTIONAL DISCHARGE OF A FIREARM, GBI**

It is further alleged as to the defendant(s), BRYAN MUNOZ, in the commission of the foregoing offenses, a principal personally and intentionally discharged a firearm, to wit: a shotgun, and proximately caused death to a person other than the accomplice, to wit: ENZO MARINO RASTELLI and JASPER PIETER VANDERMEULEN, within the meaning of §12022.53 (d) & (e) of the Penal Code.

**SPEC ALLEG – SERIOUS/VIOLENT/REGISTERABLE SEX OFFENSE FELONY**

It is further alleged as to Counts 1-3, that the above offenses are serious felonies within the meaning of Penal Code section 1192.7(c) and/or a violent felony described in subdivision(s) of Penal Code section 667.5 and/or an offense requiring registration under the provisions Penal Code sections 290 et seq, pursuant to Penal Code section 1170(h), that the defendants BRYAN MUNOZ and JOSHUA ISAAC VEGA are ineligible for a state prison sentence to be served in the county jail.


“NOTICE: Pursuant to Penal Code section 1170(f), notwithstanding any other provisions of this section, for purposes of subdivision (h) of section 1170, any allegation that a defendant is ineligible for a state prison sentence to be served in the county jail due to a prior or current conviction, or sentence enhancement, or because he or she is required to register as a sex offender, or because the legislature specifically excluded the offense, shall not be subject to dismissal pursuant to §1385 PC.”
