- III. **Status update regarding Proposition 47 (Prop. 47) Executive Steering Committee and the local Prop. 47 Committee overseen by the County Executive Office** – Budget Director Tom Alvarez
The Board of State and Community Corrections has appointed an Executive Steering Committee to administer Prop. 47 recidivism reduction grant funding. Santa Barbara County's Prop. 47 Committee is responsible for providing updates to the Board of Supervisors.
- IV. **JFA Institute Realignment Strategic Planning Presentation** – James Austin, Ph.D.
JFA Institute has been contracted to conduct a study examining the first five (5) years of CCP/Realignment funding and programs, and a review of the County's strategies to ensure the Realignment Plan is adequately achieving the goals of the "justice reinvestment" outlined in Penal Code sections 1230.1 and 3450. The draft report and recommendations will be presented and discussed.

The Public Safety Realignment local plan is updated on an annual basis. The workgroup's priority assignment is the planning and preparation of a local plan and budget for presentation to the CCP. As part of the planning process, the group will review the Realignment Plan's goals and determine if any modifications are recommended. Formation of additional subgroups for the planning process will also be considered.
- VII. **Status update on Pre-Trial Services' Planning Effort/Timeline of Anticipated Milestones** – Court Executive Officer Darrel Parker
Receive an update regarding the re-design of the local Pre-Trial Services (PTS) program and the use of an evidence-based PTS risk assessment tool.

- VIII. **Realignment Population Update and Projections for Fiscal Year 2017-2018** – Supervising Probation Officer Sylvia Talaugon
In preparation for development of the Fiscal Year 2017-2018 Realignment Plan, current numbers and projections will be presented for the Post Sentence Supervision and Post Release Community Supervision populations.

The Stepping Up Initiative is designed to help advance counties' efforts to reduce the number of adults with mental illness and co-occurring substance use disorders in jails.

The Criminal Justice Funding Decision Protocol was established to collaboratively vet funding opportunities being considered by County agencies, and to enhance said analysis via use of the Results First tool.
