Dear Supervisors,

I am a property owner in Santa Ynez, California and my property adjoins the Camp 4 property. I understand that Public meetings have been set with an unusually short time frame and scheduled for October 5 and 9, 2017 to address the tentative “Intergovernmental Memorandum of Agreement – Camp 4” between Santa Barbara County and the Santa Ynez Band of Chumash Indians (“Tribe”) to allow the development of camp 4 which includes 143 homes, tribal facilities, water, treatment facilities, roads and infrastructure amongst other things.

In order for there to be complete transparency and public confidence and faith in the political process, it is respectfully requested that **EACH** member of the Board of Supervisors, as a candidate or incumbent, disclose all amounts, if any, received as political contributions from the Tribe, Tribal members, or any tribe operating a gambling casino, or any tribal organization. This request relates to any and all political received by board members as a candidate or incumbent in the last 5 years.

It is requested the amounts of any political contribution be publically disclosed **PRIOR** to the next Public meeting scheduled for October 5, 2017 **and posted on the Santa Barbara County website.**
