**Re: Intergovernmental Memorandum of Agreement - Camp 4
Political Contributions by the Tribe(s) to Board of Supervisors
Public Hearing - - October 5, 2017**

Dear Supervisors Hartmann, Williams, Adam, Wolf and Lavagnino:

My wife and I live in Santa Ynez, California, and we are neighbors of the Chumash Tribe with respect to Camp 4. I understand Public Meetings have been set on unusually short notice for October 5 and 9, 2017, to address the tentative "Intergovernmental Memorandum of Agreement - Camp 4" between Santa Barbara County and the Santa Ynez Band of Chumash Indians ("Tribe") to allow the development of Camp 4 which includes 143 homes, tribal facilities, water treatment facilities, roads and infrastructure, among other things.

In order for there to be complete transparency and public confidence and faith in the political process, it is respectfully requested that **each** member of the Board of Supervisors, as a candidate or incumbent, disclose all amounts, if any, received as political contributions from the Tribe, Tribal members, any tribe operating a gambling casino, and any tribal organization. This request relates to any and all political contributions received by Board members as a candidate or incumbent in the last five (5) years.

It is requested the amounts of any such political contribution be publically disclosed **prior** to the next Public Meeting on October 5, 2017, and posted on the County's website.

Please post this letter on the County's website for the upcoming hearing.
