*An Updated Assessment can only be used when client has a current Comprehensive or Clinical Assessment

*An Updated Assessment is required when there is a change in diagnosis or functional Impairments, and as needed to support a change in level of care

*Updated Assessments must be able to "stand alone;" all diagnosis criteria for all diagnosis is required

*Updated Assessments are not required when clients change programs if there are no changes to diagnosis or functional impairments
