Staff 1: Assisted with access, walk-ins, assessment and few cases in therapy. Staff schedule was the second and fourth Thursday of each month. In October, 2016, this was expanded to four half days a month (Thursdays).

Staff 2: Assisted mainly with individual treatment for the children and support to their families. Staff performed some assessments, and the schedule is every Tuesday afternoon.

This information doesn't include direct referrals from Carpinteria Children's Project which were screened and referred out.
