**Request/Question:**

What has been the annual AB109 Realignment funding appropriated to the Sheriff each year for electronic monitoring, going back to the inception of the Community Corrections Partnership? What other funds have been used for electronic monitoring? And what has been the average annual number of inmates utilizing electronic monitoring?

The Community Corrections Partnership allocates funds to the Sheriff's Office for electronic monitoring program that is available to the general jail population, which is inclusive of Realigned offenders providing they meet eligibility criteria. The funds allocated to the Sheriff's Office include Probation's realigned offenders.

Budgetary funding since inception:

- FY 12/13 - \$287,438
- FY 13/14 - \$200,000
- FY 14/15 - \$120,000
- FY 15/16 - \$115,000
- FY 16/17 - \$75,000
- FY 17/18 - \$73,000
- FY 18/19 - \$73,000
- FY 18/19 - \$73,000

In prior fiscal years, electronic monitoring was also paid for by a JAG/Bryne Grant that was awarded to the County of Santa Barbara for the funding of a Regional Crime Abatement team. Inmates that are not realigned and participate in the electronic monitoring program have their fees paid for using General Fund.

Total electronic monitoring inmates booked:

- Fiscal 2012-2013 EM= 1147
- Fiscal 2013-2014 EM= 1035
- Fiscal 2014-2015 EM= 736
- Fiscal 2015-2016 EM= 751
- Fiscal 2016-2017 EM= 888
- Fiscal 2017-2018 EM= 971
