The undersigned is informed and believes that:

COUNT 1

On or about June 5, 2019, in the County of Santa Barbara, the crime of WILLFUL, DELIBERATE, PREMEDITATED MURDER, in violation of **PENAL CODE SECTION 187(a)**, a Felony, was committed by MELISSA LEIGH MARTIN, who did unlawfully and with malice aforethought murder ELDRI TERESE JAUCH, a human being.

It is further alleged that the above offense is a serious felony within the meaning of **Penal Code Section 1192.7(c)(1)**.

It is further alleged that the above offense is a violent felony pursuant to **Penal Code Section 667.5(c)(1)**.

SPEC ALLEG-USE OF DEADLY WEAPON


