NEW CHARGES FILED IN CASE AGAINST CORONA MAN ACCUSED OF KIDNAPPING LOMPOC TEEN

Re: People v. Saul Padilla

Santa Barbara County District Attorney Joyce Dudley announced today that new charges were filed in the case against Saul Padilla, a 47-year old Corona, California, man who is currently facing charges of kidnapping and lewd act on a child after an arrest in Vandenberg Village on Sunday, January 8, 2012. As a result of the continuing investigation by Santa Barbara Sheriff's Detectives Bosma and Gamboa, the defendant now faces an additional charge of forcible sexual penetration of a minor along with the allegation that the sex offense occurred during a kidnapping. The defendant is due back in Lompoc Court on January 17, 2012, at which time the prosecution will seek to address the court regarding bail.
