In an abundance of caution and in an effort to slow the spread of COVID-19, effective Tuesday March 17, 2020, the County of Santa Barbara Elections Division will close our doors to the public in compliance with Governor Newsom's order "to prohibit ALL gatherings of any size, effective immediately".

We will continue to accept service requests by mail or fax.

Staff is available from 8:00 a.m. Noon and 1:00 to 5:00 p.m. to answer calls and can setup an appointment for services if it is determined necessary.

There are 24-hour drop boxes located outside our offices in Santa Barbara and Santa Maria to receive completed voter registration forms, voted ballots for the San Antonio Basin Water District Formation Election, completed No Signature and Signature Verification Statements for the March 3, 2020 Presidential Primary Election or any other forms and mail for our office. These drop boxes will be checked daily.
