#### **Who can participate?**

Santa Barbara County **permanent** employees who are registered voters in any county in the State of California, or lawfully permitted for permanent residence in the United States in accordance with 8 U.S.C. Sec. 1101(a)(2) and otherwise eligible to vote pursuant to Elections Code Section 2101 except for his/her lack of U.S. citizenship.

#### **How to apply:**

- Complete attached application
- Obtain approval from Department Head or their designee.

#### **Program details:**

- The employee will work at an assigned polling place in Santa Barbara County.
- The shift is from **6:00 a.m. to approximately 9:00 p.m. Part time positions are NOT AVAILABLE.**
- Pre-approved time off to attend training class during the employee's normal work schedule is allowed under the program and the employee will be paid their normal wages for this time off.

#### **Training:**

- Classes are by appointment only. There are both day and evening classes scheduled approximately 2 ½ weeks before the election. Time off to attend training during your normal work hours must be approved by your Supervisor and you will be paid your normal wages.

#### **Wages/Stipends:**

Participants will receive their normal wages for those hours worked during their normal work schedule, and shall not include overtime. Participants will also receive a stipend ranging from \$180-\$240 depending on the position assigned.
