HEALTH SECURITY SAFETY

The Department of Social Services is committed to assisting you with your future success! Did you know that individuals who discontinue from the CalWORKs program may continue to have access to the following benefits and services?:

- **CalFresh ***
- **Medi-Cal ***
- **Child Care ***
 - You might be eligible to receive Child Care assistance if requested within 24 months of CalWORKs discontinuance. Contact the Children's Resource and Referral at (805) 925-7071 for additional information.
- **Employment Connection Center**
 - You can continue to receive resume, application, and interview assistance.

Homeless Assistance

If you were receiving Housing Support Program (HSP) assistance at the time of the CalWORKs discontinuance for over income, you may continue to receive the homeless assistance services approved with the HSP Stability Plan.

Subsidized Employment (JOB\$)

If the subsidized income caused the CalWORKs discontinuance, you might be allowed to complete your job placement and continue to receive subsidized income during the duration of the placement.

Resource Support Team (RST)

You may continue to receive substance abuse and/or mental health treatment via a community or private provider if you were receiving RST services at the time of CalWORKs/Welfare-to-Work discontinuance. RST will contact you to discuss referrals for continuation of services.

You continue to have access to the 24 hour ACCESS Line at (888) 868-1649 for information, screening, and referral to Substance Use Disorder Treatment and Mental Health Services in Santa Barbara County.

* If you were receiving these benefits at the time of CalWORKs discontinuance, your worker will send a referral for you to continue to receive these benefits without interruption. You do not have to re-apply *unless* you received a separate notice specifically terminating these benefits.

NOTE: Some of these services might not always be available or the delivery and administration of the programs might be modified. Please, contact your local Social Services office if you have any questions.
