**Section 6.20.030: No person shall own or keep any dog within the Lompoc City limits that the person knows, or should know, has not been spayed or neutered. This section does not apply to animals meeting the criteria below:**

**MEDICAL EXEMPTION**       Permanent     Temporary

Applies to dogs which are unable to be spayed or neutered without a high likelihood of suffering serious bodily harm or death due to age or infirmity.

**Requirements:** Written confirmation from a licensed veterinarian is required to qualify for this exemption. The written confirmation must be an original document and it must be submitted on the veterinary clinic stationary.

**LAW ENFORCEMENT**

Law Enforcement dogs are dogs that are used by public law enforcement agencies for law enforcement purposes.

**Requirements:** Documentation from a public law enforcement agency certifying that the dog is used for law enforcement purposes by that agency is required to qualify for this exemption.

**SERVICE OR ASSISTANCE DOG**

A Service Dog is a guide dog or seeing-eye dog which was trained by a person licensed under Chapter 9.5 (commencing with Section 7200) of Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code, a signal dog or other dog individually trained to do work or perform tasks for the benefit of an individual with a disability, including, but not limited to, guiding individuals with impaired vision, alerting individuals with impaired hearing to intruders or sounds, providing minimal protection or rescue work, pulling a wheelchair or fetching dropped items.

**Requirements:** The dog owner must provide documentation satisfactory to the Department that certifies the dog in question is a qualified Service Dog and the dog must have a Service Dog license with a completed affidavit.

**SHOW OR BREEDING DOG**

A Show or Breeding Dog is a dog which is used to show, to compete or to breed, which is of a breed recognized by and registered with the American Kennel Club (AKC), United Kennel Club (UKC), American Dog Breeders Association (ADBA) or other approved breed registry, evidence of which must be submitted with this request form. Other evidence may include documentation that the dog has been or is being trained for the purpose of show, field trials, or agility trials.
