### September 25, 2020 Public Notice

Engel & Gray Inc. Regional Composting Facility Solid Waste Facility Permit #42-AA-0053 and facility address at 745 West Betteravia Road, Santa Maria, CA 93456

Application for revision to Report of Composting Site Information received from Engel & Gray Inc. Regional Composting Facility on July 22, 2020 with a subsequent revision received on September 23, 2020.

Included with the application are the updated RCSI amendments to reflect changes including clarifications, such as the number and type of compost equipment, permitted traffic volume, Fire Prevention plan and revised site plans for the east and west portions of the composting site to denote a clear separation between the adjacent retention basin and any composting operations.

The RCSI Amendment was accepted for processing on September 24, 2020 and pursuant to Title 27, section 21665 (c) has been found to be consistent with all applicable California Environmental Quality Act documents. The proposed changes are consistent with state minimum standards and do not conflict with the terms and conditions in the SWFP as reviewed on March 19, 2020. Therefore, the changes represented by the subject RCSI Amendment do not require a revision of the current SWFP.
