Bloodborne Pathogen Training for Body Art Practitioners

EHS approves bloodborne pathogen (BBP) training venues that have been approved by other counties within the State of California. Body art practitioners must provide a certificate with a minimum of two hours of BBP training renewed annually. Training records must be kept on file for three years.
