



## Public Information Meeting 5:30 pm, October 21, 2019

### Application for a new Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) #42-AA-0069 Received from Valley Garbage and Rubbish Company Inc, DBA Health Sanitation Services/Waste Management on August 28, 2019

The operator, Health Sanitation Services located at 1850 West Betteravia Road, Santa Maria, CA 93455, has submitted an application for a new SWFP to combine the operations of an existing Medium Volume Transfer Station (MVTS), a green waste Chip and Grind operation, and a material recovery facility under one full SWFP as a Large Volume Transfer Station. The combined facility will receive a maximum of 454 tons per day, comprised of the existing maximum permit limits of 99.9 TPD of municipal solid waste and construction & demolition debris, and 199 TPD green waste, and the historical peak of 155.3 TPD recyclables. The 9.06-acre facility is open for receiving Monday to Sunday from 6 am to 5 pm, and for material processing from Monday to Sunday 6 am to 9 pm.

Environmental Health Services (EHS) as the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) under the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) will host a public information meeting that is scheduled to take place at 5:30 pm on October 21, 2019. The LEA accepted the application as complete and correct on September 27, 2019. The purpose of the meeting is to make public the LEA processing of the subject permit application to issue a new SWFP.

A copy of the permit application is on file and is available for public inspection in the LEA office located at 2125 S. Centerpointe Parkway, Rm. 333, Santa Maria, CA 93455 Monday to Friday from 8 to 11:45 am, and from 1 to 4:30 pm.
