RE: Pollution Prevention and Clean Water – Routine Business Inspection

Dear Business Owner/Manager,

To protect water quality and prevent pollution from entering our creeks, groundwater, and ocean, the County of Santa Barbara conducts routine business inspections for clean water.

This letter is to notify you that County staff will visit the above-referenced business. We will look for sources of pollutants and help identify improvements to eliminate potential polluted discharges, if needed.

The purpose of this program is to bring awareness of storm water pollution and support voluntary compliance with rules that protect clean water. It is illegal for polluted discharges to enter the storm drain system (Santa Barbara County Code Chapter 29 Article IV).

Unscheduled inspections will be made by a clean water inspector during regular business hours throughout the period January 2010 through June, 2011. You may contact us directly at 568-3440 to schedule an appointment if that is your preference.
